Bed Bug Response

In the event of a "Hit" on Bed Bugs,

1. Inform Property Manager and Camp Manager. ***Do not relocate any items***, as they may contain bed bugs.
2. Second Inspection will be performed (dog will be brought in if deemed necessary).

If No,

1. If no signs of Bed Bugs found, follow ***LOP Bunkhouse Preparation & Bed Bug Prevention*** again.

If Yes,

1. Bag all clothing in clear plastic bags, launder and dry on high heat for 45 minutes minimum. *
2. Disassemble and move all furniture to basement walk in freezer for 72 hours.
3. Completely seal & re-treat room*, keep room sealed for *24 hours*.
 - Fogging with Cedar Oil
 - Cedar Soap
 - DE
4. Staff involved remove clothing, bag and launder at Ranch, ***do not take your clothes home until treated, even footwear.***
5. All other rooms in Bunkhouse will be thoroughly inspected, daily room tracking begins.
6. Once ***"Clear"***, follow ***LOP Bunkhouse Preparation & Bed Bug Prevention*** again.

Campers,

7. Camper will be given clean clothing to wear and relocated to another room in Bunkhouse or Main Lodge until room is deemed ***"Clear"***.

Personal items that can't be easily washed will be treated by Maintenance Team in the appropriate methods outlined in the Bed Bug Outbreak Management binder.
